

THE SOLUTION TO SAFE GUARDRAIL INSTALLATION











STEP 1

Lay your guardrail into position with one end on the ground and the other in the half clamp on the bracket. Place The Rail Racer on top of the guardrail near the other end of the guardrail, ensuring the pole handle is at 90 degrees to the guardrail. Pull the rope to actuate the clamp and The Rail Racer will drop over the guardrail. Release the rope and check that the clamp has closed fully.

STEP 2

Hold The Rail Racer firmly with both hands and lift the guardrail up and over the bracket and into the half clamp. Ensure the other end of the guardrail doesn't slide or jump out during this process.

STEP 3

Pull the rope to actuate the clamp and turn The Rail Racer to one side to disengage it from the guardrail.

Note: the pole must be in the neutral position, i.e not hard over to one side.

STEP 4

Check that your guardrail is sitting in the half clamps safely. If necessary, adjust left or right by re clamping the guardrail and pulling sideways. Consecutive rails are installed in the same manner, preferable with joiners pre-fitted.

Disassembly is a reversal of the above mentioned procedure.
